INVITATION TO BID

NATIONAL ROAD LIGHTING PROGRAM SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF LUMINAIRES NCR (PACKAGE 6)

1. The **Road Board (RB)**, through the **MVUC Special Road Support Fund (Fund-151) for CY-2014** intends to apply the sum of **One Hundred Fifteen Million Six Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Pesos (Php115,639,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **National Road Lighting Program *Supply and Installation of Luminaires NCR (Package 6)***. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The **Road Board** now invites bidders to bid for **National Road Lighting Program *Supply and Installation of Luminaires NCR (Package 6)***, consisting of supply, delivery, and installation of LED street lights to and along the following sites/locations;

Bidders should have completed **prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids either (a) a single contract that is similar to the contract to be bid, whose value, adjusted to current prices using the National Statistics Office (NSO) consumer price indices, must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC, or (b) at least two (2) similar contracts whose aggregate amounts should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC, provided that the largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least twenty-five percent (25%) of the ABC.** The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183 and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information, inspect and purchase the complete set of Bidding Documents from the **RB BAC Secretariat Office, 2nd Floor Ave Maria Building, 1517 Quezon Avenue cor. Examiner St., Quezon City**, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php50,000.00)** from **March 26, 2014 up to 12:00 noon of May 5, 2014.**

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and from the Procuring Entity’s website, provided that Bidders shall pay the non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

Bidders who have previously purchased the Bidding Documents for Package 6 from February 14th (date of advertisement) to March 21st (declaration of failure) of 2014 need not pay the said amount.

5. The **Road Board** will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on **April 4, 2014 (Friday) 1:00 PM** at the **RBS Conference Room, 4th Floor Ave Maria Building, 1517 Quezon Avenue cor. Examiner St., Quezon City.** The conference shall be open only to all interested parties who have purchased the Bidding Documents. **Interested parties who have not purchased the bidding documents will be allowed to attend as observers only.**
6. Bids must be delivered to the RB BAC Secretariat Office on or before **May 5, 2014 (Monday) 12:00 noon.** All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 18.

Bids will be opened on **May 5, 2014, 2014 (Monday) 1:00 PM** at the **RBS Conference Room** in the presence of the attending bidders' representatives. Late bids shall not be accepted.

7. The Road Board reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
