BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING FAILURE OF BIDDING

BAC RESOLUTION No. 2015-050

WHEREAS, the **Road Board** advertised the Invitation to Bid for the National Road Lighting Program Supply and Installation of Luminaires (Package 9) with an Approved Budget for the Contract of Ninety-Seven Million Four Hundred Eighteen Thousand Eight-Hundred Pesos (P 97,418,800.00) in the April 8, 2015 issue of the The Philippine Star and through posting in the RB website and in the PhilGEPS during the period of April 8-14, 2015;

WHEREAS, in response to the said Invitation, three (3) prospective bidders purchased and three (3) submitted bid documents;

WHEREAS, during the Opening and Preliminary Examination of Bids on May 12, 2015, one (1) bidder was found ineligible which resulted to disqualification, and two (2) bids were opened;

WHEREAS, during Post-Qualification, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) found that there is a significant reduction in the current price of luminaires;

WHEREAS, it would be more beneficial to the government if the budget cost per luminaire be adjusted to a lower price without compromising the quality of the technical specifications thereof;


WHEREAS, Section 1, Invitation to Bid item number 7 of the bidding document states that *"The Road Board reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders;*

WHEREAS, Section 41 (c) of the IRR of RA 9184 states that *"The Head of the Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bid, or not award the contract in the following situations: (c) for any justifiable and reasonable ground where the award of the contract will not redound to the benefit of the GOP, as follows (i) if the physical and economic conditions have significantly changed so as to render the project no longer economically, financially, or technically feasible, as determined by the Head of the Procuring Entity:";*

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED**:

- a. Declare failure and not to award a contract in relation to the bidding for the project National Road Lighting Program Supply and Installation of Luminaires (Package 9) held on 12 May 2015;
- b. Conduct a new bidding based on the current lower price of luminaires.
